
Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the session:

- All pupils will know that there are lots of colours, patterns, and shapes found in nature
- Most pupils will understand some reasons why animals have different colours and patterns
- Some pupils will be able to make links between their own work and famous wildlife artists

Session Outline:

The session starts with historical examples of animals drawn from descriptions, then showcases works by famous British wildlife artists who focused on nature. Using provided sketchbooks, children will rotate through art activities emphasizing color, pattern, and shape, with hands-on opportunities to draw from real furs, feathers, and other nature objects. The session concludes with an overview of the diverse techniques and mediums used by contemporary British wildlife artists.
