Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the session:

- ✓ **All pupils** will know why some animals have bright colours whilst other animals use camouflage
- ✓ **Most pupils** will understand how camouflage and mimicry work to benefit the animal
- ✓ **Some pupils** will start to understand how different types of camouflage work better in certain situations

Session Outline:

The session begins by exploring why some animals have bright colors and their meanings, followed by a discussion on camouflage—how it works and the role of patterns, colors, and mimicry. Biofacts, videos, and activities will reinforce these topics throughout.
