Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the session:

- ✓ **All pupils will** learn how to interact and investigate biology artefacts
- ✓ **Most pupils will** start to understand how criteria can be used to organise organisms
- ✓ **Some pupils will** be able to clearly identify differences and similarities between multiple organisms

Session Outline:

In this session, students will get hands-on with real and replica artifacts, including furs, skins, feathers, horns, and skulls. They will engage in word association, fact-finding, and sorting activities with the artifacts. The session can be tailored to focus on specific areas such as habitats, diet, and classification, while also using the artifacts to enhance language skills and observations.
