The session explores how tourist attractions balance visitor numbers with profitability, using Colchester Zoo as a case study. It covers financial objectives, costs, revenue, and business operations. Direct, indirect, fixed, and variable costs are discussed, along with pricing strategies, factors affecting attendance, and the breakeven point.
