

Habitats

Where do animals live and how do they live there?

Year 2

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the session:

- ✓ **All pupils** will be aware that there are a variety of habitats all around the world
- ✓ **Most pupils** will be able to name an animal that live in each discussed habitat
- ✓ **Some pupils** will be able to explain how animals are suited (adapted) to the habitat where they live

Session Outline:

The session introduces the concept of habitats by exploring five types: woodland, rainforest, taiga, desert, and savannah through sounds and videos. Pupils learn about each habitat's climate, plants, and animals, with a detailed look at one animal per habitat. Hands-on exploration of biofacts helps pupils understand how these animals survive.
