Where do animals live and how do they live there?

Year 3-4

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the session:

- ✓ **All pupils** will be aware that there are a wide variety of habitats around the world
- ✓ **Most pupils** will be able to name animals that live in these habitats
- ✓ **Some pupils** will be able to describe animal adaptations to each habitat

Session Outline:

The session introduces the concept of habitats by exploring five types: woodland, taiga, reforest, savannah, and desert through sounds and videos. Pupils learn about each habitat's climate, plants, and animals, with a detailed look at one animal per habitat. Hands-on exploration of biofacts helps pupils understand how these animals survive.
