Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the session:

- ✓ All pupils will know that rainforests are places with many plants and animals, as well as a place where it rains a lot
- ✓ Most pupils will remember some of the animals found in rainforests
- ✓ Some pupils will remember at least one feature of an animal

Session Outline:

The session introduces rainforests through videos, followed by a story that begins in the African rainforest, moves to Asia, and ends in South America. In each rainforest, the focus is on identifying a strange sound by exploring the animals found there. Videos, biofacts, and interactive activities highlight key features of these animals and their behavior. The story concludes with the discovery of the animal making the sound.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the session:

- ✓ All pupils will know where the main rainforests are found - Africa, Asia and South America
- ✓ Most pupils will remember a feature of an animal's behaviour or biology
- ✓ Some pupils will understand how the features of the animals help them in the rainforest
